TEAM MANAGER'S

City Touch Office

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Team Manager (TM):

The TM is responsible for the communication between the office and their team. By signing up as the TM and nominating the team, please ensure you have read your roles and responsibilities in the <u>Competition Regulations</u>.

Individual Registration:

<u>Players must be individually registered to the team prior to taking the field.</u> Once the team has been nominated online, all players are required to individually register to the team on MySideline. This can be completed on the City Touch Website: <u>Join Your Registered Team</u>

Please note: You, as the Team Manager, must also register to the team as a player.

The TM will be able to view the registered players to the team at any time throughout the season. Upon nominating their team, the TM will receive access to MySideline Manager. Once logged in, click on the menu button in the top left corner, then Select your team (The most recently registered team will appear at the bottom of this drop down list). Select My Members to view your registered players.

Individual Registration - Touch Football Australia (TFA) National Membership:

<u>Touch Football Australia National Membership</u> – Every Individual player will need to pay a \$22 affiliation fee to Touch Football Australia upon registering to play each financial year. Membership includes:

- Insurance Cover for Injury (Registration Date must precede the date of injury)
- Affiliated Membership with Touch Football Australia What does this mean?
- Finals Eligibility later in the season. (Unregistered Players will be unable to take the field through finals).
- Access to important information updates, opportunities, and events.
- Access to other Membership Benefits.

MySideline Game Times:

MySideline is used nationally. Game times will appear in the time zone that your device is set to! If you are in another time zone and your phone automatically updates date and time, the Mysideline website will display game times in this current time zone. If this is unclear, or just to avoid any error, please ask a teammate currently located in Brisbane to double check your game time.

Draw Release

Draws will be released Friday prior to Round 1 games commencing. Team Managers will be notified once the draw is published. Initially only Round 1 is released due to the number of late changes, nominations and pull outs. Rounds 2 & 3 & 4 will then be published. After initial grading Rounds 5-10 will then be released. Rounds 11-14 will then be released after grading reassessment at Round 10.

Grading

When nominating, pools start at Pool 1 (the most competitive grade) and can extend up to Pool 4 (The Most Social grade). Teams are graded after Round 3 into Grades (B, C, D, etc..). Any grading requests



must be submitted in writing to the office before Round 3 to be taken into consideration. The office will monitor grades up until round 10 to ensure they remain competitive and enjoyable.

Rules

City Touch use the TFA 8th edition rules. Full documents and policies can be viewed here.

Our competition is 7 a-side. If a team wishes to play 6 a-side the opposing team and referee will need to agree to permit play.

Seasons/Dates

City Touch – play 2 seasons throughout the year! Winter and Summer. For specific information about an upcoming season, please visit the City Touch Website.

The season will play for 14 fixture rounds plus three rounds of finals including, Quarter Finals, Semi Finals and Grand Final matches.

Forfeit Games

TMs must notify the Competition Manager of a forfeited game by 4pm of game day. Multiple forfeits after 4pm will see the team removed from the competition. Please refer to the <u>Competition Regulations</u> for more information.

*If you are no longer able to manage the team, notify the office with the new TM details (Name, contact number and email). City Touch will require the new contact to confirm that they are taking over the TM responsibilities, including the invoice being re-sent under their name.

Uniforms

All team shirts must be matching in colour with visible numbers on the back. This will be enforced by referees at the venue after round 5. Players may not be able to take the field after round 5 if they are not wearing the correct attire.

- Early games only/No Late games (First 2 timeslots)
- Late games only/No Early games (Last 2 timeslots)

Special requests must be submitted via e-mail to office@citytouch.com.au. Only once your special request has been confirmed by the office via e-mail has your request been entered. We cannot grant specific time slots, but we will do our very best to accommodate. Please note that due to draw restraints, requests cannot be granted every week but will be met as often as possible for a minimum of 70% of the season.
